2007 “Business Meeting” Minutes

WEDNESDAY, March 28, 2007

President Bullock called the 2007 Conference Business Meeting to order at 11:00 am on Wednesday, March 28, 2007.

She recognized Secretary/Treasurer Blevins and asked that he read the minutes from last year's Business Meeting held during the 2006 Conference in Arlington, Texas

The minutes were read, after which President Bullock received a motion and a second to accept the minutes followed by an “all in favor” vote. There were no suggested additions or deletions. The minutes stand as read.

Next point of business, President Bullock asked for the treasurer's report. Treasurer Blevins referred to a packet of containing many copies of the 2007 Treasurer's Report in case anyone in the audience wanted one. She moved on to Committee Reports:

- ✓ AUDIT COMMITTEE: Marlon Buzek, NE and Sandra Lancaster, AR audited the books, including the checkbook, of the treasurer and reported to discrepancies.

- ✓ NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE: Past President Ruth Hendy, TX read the list of nominated Executive Board nominees and submitted the list for approval of the membership. The list includes: President – Mary Fandrey, MO; Vice President Tressa Madden, OK; Secretary/Treasurer David Blevins; Member at Large (2 positions), Marlon Buzek, NE / Tressa Madden, OK, Angela Kohls, KS as AFDO Representative and Teresa Bullock , Past President. There was a motion to accept by acclamation the slate of officers for 2008. The membership all applauded and there were no dissenting votes.
- ✓ RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE: It was decided to table this committee report until a special Business Meeting to be called tomorrow at the end of the conference, Thursday, March 29<sup>th</sup> at or about 11:00 am.

There was a motion, second and an “all in favor” vote to adjourn the Business Meeting.
